

"Mr.StarCity" Resume



David "Mr.StarCity" White (b. 1979, Brooklyn, New York City) is a multidisciplinary artist working across painting, sculpture, poetry, performance, video and installation art. While he creates figurative and abstract works through his spontaneous and constantly evolving, highly experimental practice, White's undying commitment to spreading positivity while uplifting the spirits of his community remains constant throughout his body of work. Using found objects and any materials available at hand, sourcing from both real and imagined histories, his works are full of texture and infused with a deep sense of his physical and emotional surroundings. While identifying and unmasking societal ills, White addresses themes that live within the shared experiences of contemporary culture.

The emotional and spiritual energy of When We Bloom offers a promise of optimism—a celebration of life, growth, and human connection. With each stroke of paint and poetic line, Mr.StarCity reminds us that while life's struggles may leave their mark, the capacity to heal and bloom remains ever-present.

# About The Curator

Destinee Ross-Sutton, a Harlem-born curator, gallerist and advisor, is a leading figure in contemporary and Black art. Her groundbreaking exhibitions—*Black Voices/Black Microcosm* in Stockholm, *Black Voices: Friend of My Mind* in New York, and her *Say It Loud* series for Christie's—arrived at a pivotal reckoning for racial justice. Other transformative exhibitions include the co-curation of *4000+ Years of African Art* at the Wallhouse Museum.

During the 60th Venice Biennale, her 34-artist exhibition *Unapologetic WomXn: The Dream is the Truth* highlighted the multifaceted experiences of women across racial, cultural, and social lines. She is a staunch advocate for artists' rights globally, pioneering resale restrictions in sales agreements to ensure fair value retention for creators. She is admired not only for her curatorial acumen but also as a muse to renowned artists like Amoako Boafo and Kehinde Wiley. For the last three years, her namesake gallery has been nomadic, with regular exhibitions in places like London and New York. An outpost will open in Stockholm this spring.

Touted as a visionary by *Vogue*, *Cultured*, *and The Art Newspaper*, Ross-Sutton is reshaping the art world with her discerning eye, unwavering dedication to social change, and commitment to fostering meaningful dialogue through art.

When We Bloom marks Ross-Sutton's return to FREVO as a curator, having been the first in 2021, it is her fourth collaboration with Mr.StarCity.

Sharing the rain, your strength becomes mine.








David 'Mr.StarCity' White Growing together our love is found, 2025 BLOOMERS series Mixed media on canvas 68 x 68in



David 'Mr. StarCity' White b. 1979 (Brooklyn, NY) Lives and works in New York, NY David White (a.k.a. "Mr.StarCity") is a multidisciplinary visual artist whose work spans a diverse range of media across painting, sculpture, poetry, music, performance, film, photography and installation art. Growing up across Brooklyn during the '80's, Mr. StarCity spent his childhood and formative years creating large-scale murals in memorial to the many friends he lost to violence. It was when Mr. StarCity began painting that he found his calling and discovered its potential to affect community, uplift spirits and create positive change through the healing power of art.


Throughout his works, Mr.StarCity critically addresses the lasting effects of generational trauma on identity, emotional well-being, and the stigmas associated with mental illnesses. As a social expressionist of the human condition, Mr. StarCity's work continues to be inspired by real-life experiences and encounters with strangers, friends, family and figures that extend beyond the representational. His extended research into human emotion helps to break down stigmas and taboos in relation to mental and emotional well-being.

A self-taught artist, Mr. StarCity's practice is unrestricted by classical, academic tenets. Drawing inspiration from his poetry and the truth of the everyday, Mr.StarCity creates figurative and expressionistic works that emerge through his spontaneous and constantly evolving, highly experimental practice. Using any materials available at hand and sourcing from both real and imagined histories, his works are full of impasto texture and infused with a deep sense of his physical and emotional surroundings, embodying an otherworldly synthesis of the beauty, passion, and conflict that define the human condition. He has become increasingly recognized for his experimental storytelling through his uniquely playful paintings complemented by his lyrical poetry.

Whatever the medium, Mr. StarCity's undying commitment to spreading positivity while uplifting the spirits of his community is palpable throughout his body of work and all channels of creation.
